

Triploid grass carp may be planted in the State of Washington after the required permits and documents are approved. These permits and documents include:

- 1. Approval to plant triploid grass carp from the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW)
- 2. A State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) determination.
- 3. Lake Restoration Study (ONLY if lake or pond is public)
- 4. Hydraulic Project Approval (ONLY if screening is required) (This is an approval that comes only after SEPA is satisfied)
- 5. Documentation from the United States Fish and Wildlife Service verifying the fish being planted are certified disease free triploid grass carp. (You will receive this from the vendor distributing the fish)

The following documents are needed to apply for a permit to plant triploid grass carp. Please follow the instructions below to ensure your application will be processed quickly.

- 1. The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife Application for Planting Triploid Grass Carp. (Attached) Follow all instructions and provide accurate answers for each question.
- 2. A completed Environmental Checklist (attached). We have provided you with information for several of the questions on that list. You <u>must</u> provide the section, township and range of the water body, a daytime phone number where you can be reached, in the event we have questions and sign and date the checklist.
- 3. The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife Fish Transport Application/Permit
  (Attached) After WDFW staff has completed their on-site evaluation and you have satisfied the State
  Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) process, you will need to complete this application and mail it to the regional
  Fish and Wildlife office in your area. There is a \$24 fee that needs to accompany this application.
- 4. If your lake or pond is public, the results of a lake restoration study must be provided to the WDFW. Please consult with your local WDFW regional office for additional direction on how to proceed with this requirement.
- 5. If the body of water to be planted with grass carp flows into another body of water, it will have to be screened. If the waterbody has to be screened you will need a <a href="Hydraulic Project Approval (HPA)">Hydraulic Project Approval (HPA)</a>, to obtain said approval you will need to complete a <a href="JARPA">JARPA</a> form. Please consult with your local WDFW regional office prior to installing a screen for additional direction on this requirement.

\*Please send all documents to the Department's regional office, which has jurisdiction in the county of your lake or pond. Your application may take approximately six to eight weeks to process. If you have any questions, please contact the same regional office where you submitted your application.

Comments: Recon surveyed on Thursday, May 24 <sup>th</sup> with Kevin Litton. This is a closed system, 16 acre pond oriented in the uplands near Zillah between Yakima Valley Highway and Interstate 82. The pond is a maximum of 10 feet deep, has no inlet or						
outlet and is fed by groundwater seepage. There is a small stream/drain nearby, but it						
is not connected to the pond in any way and there does not appear to be any flood concerns. The pond had an abundance of curly leaved pondweed and northern milfoil,						
both preferred foods of grass carp. I recommend approval for stocking sterile grass carp in the Zilla Ponds at the rate of 9 fish per surface acre (total 144 fish). The fish must be purchased from an approved vendor, be certified disease free and be a minimum of 8 inches in length.


