Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the determination on nonsignificance for the Oneida Access Area Renovation project located in 424 Oneida Road in Naselle as proposed by Chris Gourley, Washington State Department Fish & Wildlife (WDFW). The Department of Ecology (Ecology) reviewed the environmental checklist and has the following comment(s):

SHORELANDS & ENVIRONMENTAL ASSISTANCE: Rick Mraz (360) 407-6221

The planting plan appears to be inadequate to effectively promote revegetation. The plan proposes 400 tree or shrubs in a 30,000 square foot area, or 75 foot on center plantings. An appropriate restoration density for tree or shrubs species of those listed is 10 to 20 foot on center. Please provide a more detailed planting plan as a part of your application for permits.

TOXICS CLEANUP: Connie Groven (360) 407-6254

If contamination is suspected, discovered, or occurs during the proposed SEPA action, testing of the potentially contaminated media must be conducted. If contamination of soil or groundwater is readily apparent or is revealed by testing, Ecology must be notified. Contact the Environmental Report Tracking System Coordinator at the Southwest Regional Office at (360) 407-6300. For assistance and information about subsequent cleanup and to identify the type of testing that will be required contact Connie Groven with the Toxic Cleanup Program at the phone number given above.
