Thank you for your comments on SEPA number 12-5478 for the Summit Lake Access Area Improvments Project. In response to your comments, please see below:

Shorelands and Environmental Assistance: Thurston County will likely require a Substantial Development Shoreline Permit. WDFW will consult with Thurston County to determine which shoreline permits are required.

Toxics Cleanup: If contamination is suspected, discovered, or occurs during the project, WDFW shall test the potentially contaminated media. If the media is found to be contaminated, WDFW will notify Ecology's Environmental Report Tracking System Coordinator at the Southwest Regional Office.
