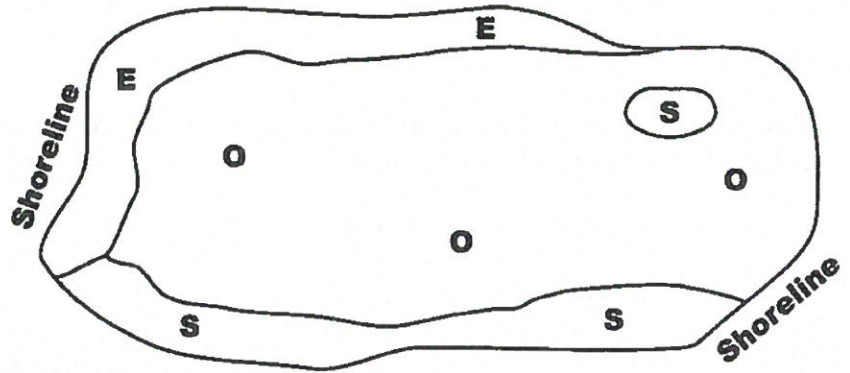

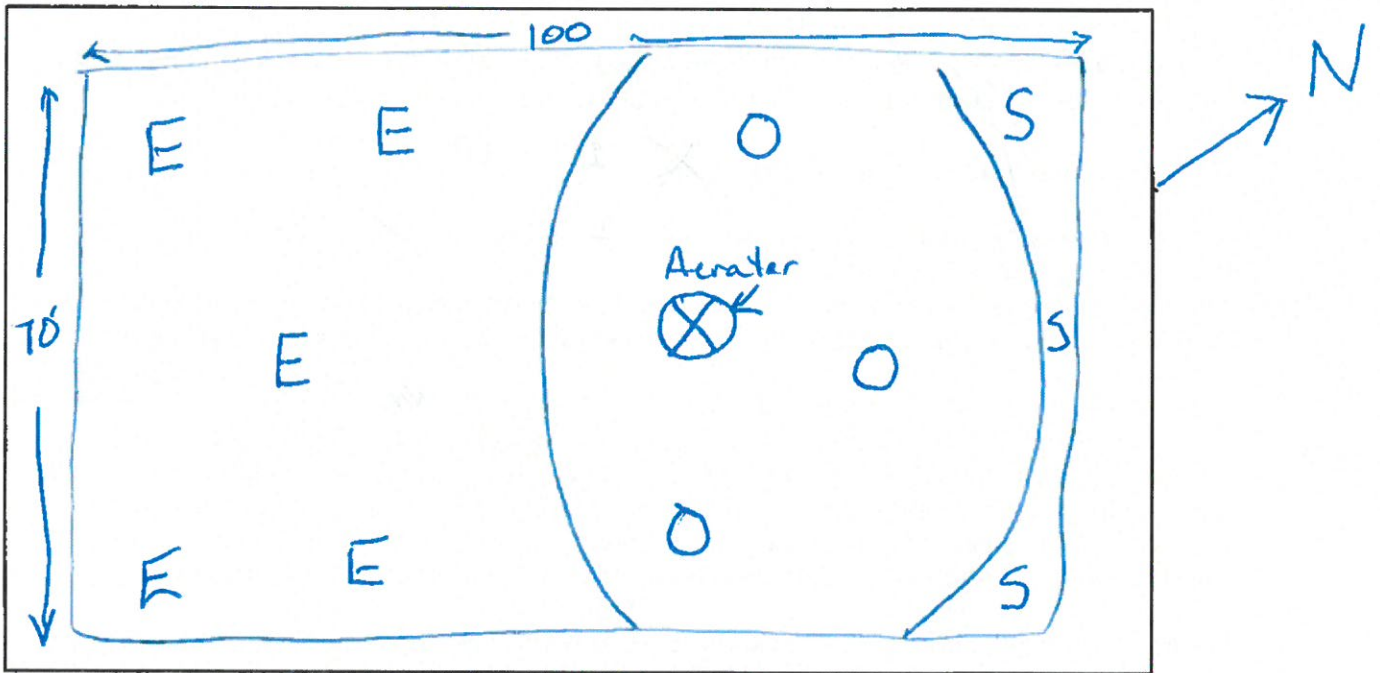

 O- Open Water

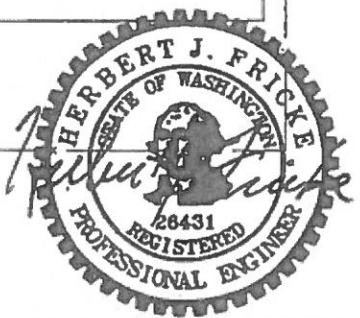
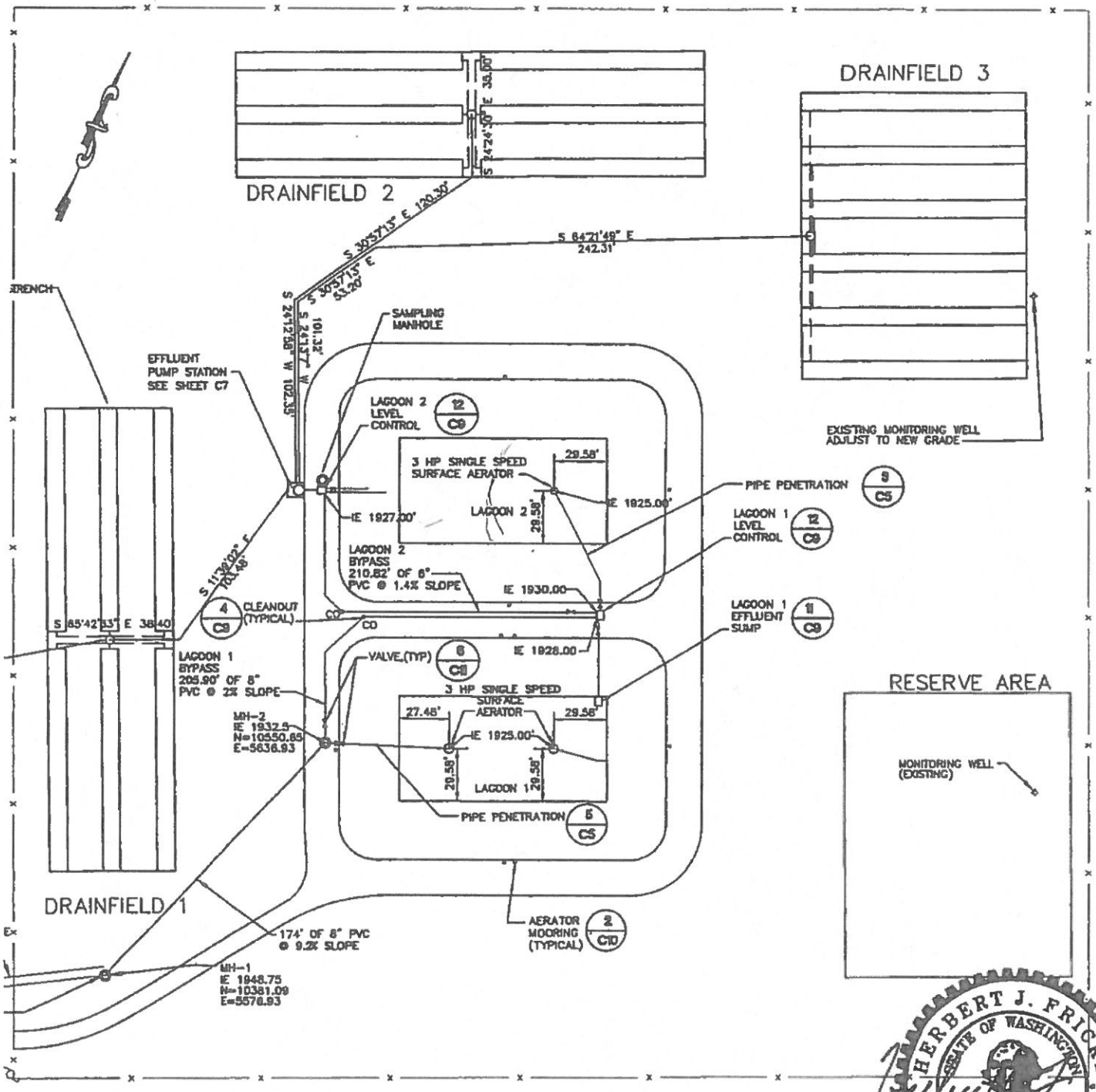
