Thank you. I think this is an adequate plan. I appreciate the 2:1 ratio which helps to address temporal impacts. My only suggestion would be to include some planting instructions (like plant in October-February so the trees don't just die, since I assume they won't be watered), performance standards (100% survival first 2 years, 90% survival years 3-5) and a monitoring plan. It doesn't do much good to install mitigation plantings if the trees do not survive.
