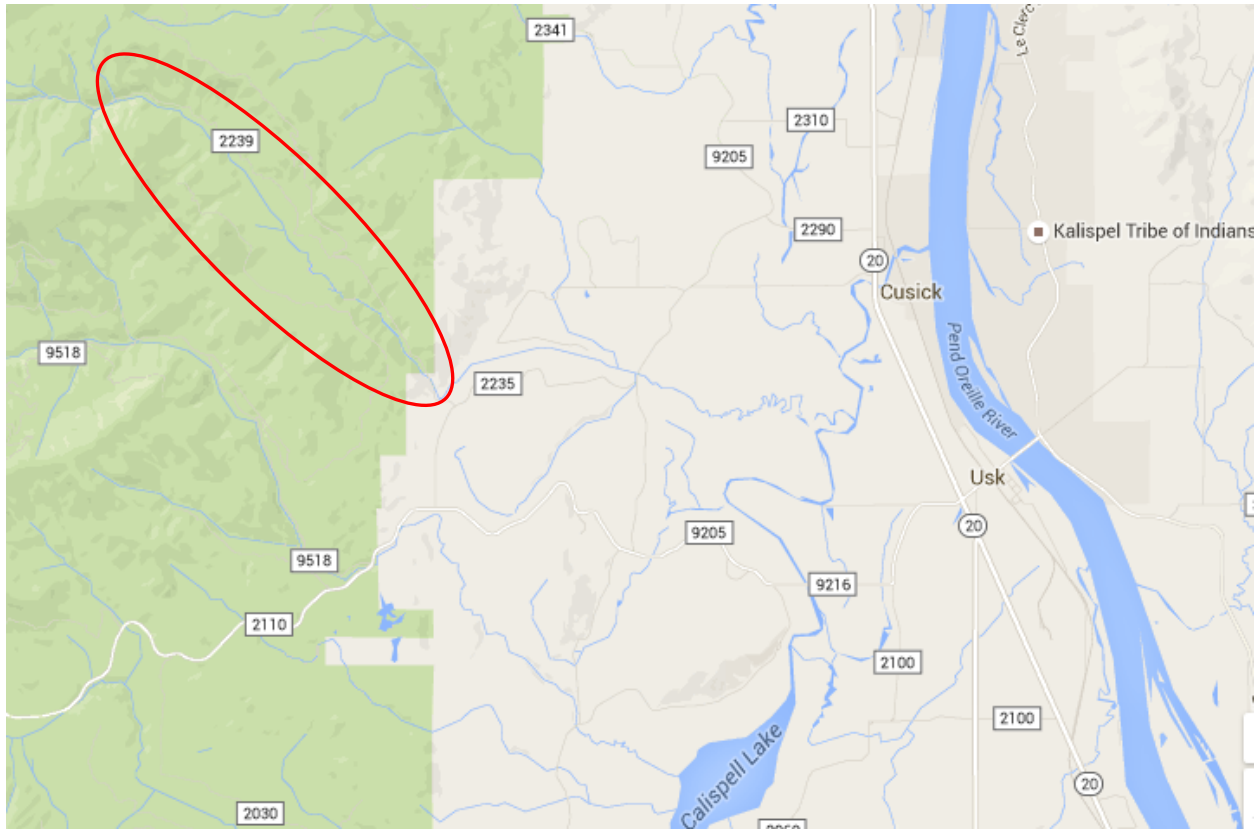

Park and Blue Lakes (Grant County) are located approximately 14 miles north of the City of Soap Lake. **Park Lake** is in Sections 10, 11, 14, 15 and 16, Township 24 North, Range 27 East WM. **Blue Lake** is in Sections 15, 16, 20, 21, 22 and 29, Township 24 North, Range 27 East WM. **Vic Meyers** is located 0.8 mile north of the northeast corner of Park Lake in section 12, Township 24 North, Range 27 East WM. **Mirror Lake** is located adjacent to the northeast corner of Park Lake in section 11, Township 24 North, Range 27 East WM. **Alkali Lake** is located 9 miles north of the City of Soap Lake in Section 31, Township 24 North, Range 27 East WM, section 36, Township 24 North, Range 26 East WM, section 1, Township 23 North, Range 26 East WM and section 6, Township 23 North, Range 27 East WM.



Smalle Creek (Pend Oreille County) is located approximately 5 miles west of Cusick, in Sections 13, 14 and 15, Township 33 North, Range 42 East WM and sections 18, 19, 20 and 29, Township 33 North, Range 43 East WM.

The proposed treatment area on Smalle Creek is estimated to be 5.09 stream miles, but could vary, depending on actual fish-bearing habitat in the main stem of Smalle Creek and its tributaries, to be determined by on-site surveys.
