**ADDENDUM 16-048 TO DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE 98-065 DATED:
AUGUST 4, 1998**

Name of DNS: 98-065: HOLTZHEIMER - GRASS CARP - WALO POND

Description of Original Proposal:

Plant triploid (sterile) grass carp into Walo Pond, with no public access, to control aquatic vegetation.

Description of Addendum 16-048:

The Environmental Checklist for the original DNS indicated that the planting of grass carp was a one-time event, in 1998. Now the project proponents are requesting to restock approximately 6 grass carp. Restocking would occur as fish die due to predation or natural die off. Current WDFW Grass Carp Policy (POL 5103) limits restocking to 5-year intervals, with the intent to not overstock the pond or lake. The required screening has been in place since the original DNS.
