No public comments were received on the SEPA determination during the SEPA public comment period. The following is a summary of comments received on the proposed HPA rule changes during the concurrent APA comment period.

## **Comments Received and Responses to Comments**

The public comment period for this rule change proposal was open from October 16<sup>th</sup> for comments on the preproposal notice, and from the February 7<sup>th</sup> publication of the rule change proposal in the Washington State Register. Comments were taken through 5:00 pm March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Five comment letters or emails were received on the proposals and are summarized below.
