WDFW has received Ecology's Comments for the proposed improvements for its Bogachiel Hatchery. WDFW has read and considered Ecology's comments and has offered the following responses:

1. WDFW will contact and coordinate the proposed hatchery improvements with the City of Forks to ensure compliance with the City of Forks Shoreline Master Program.
2. WDFW project managers will review local stormwater ordinances and the Western Washington Stormwater Manual to assure the proper erosion and sediment control practices are used to prevent sediment impacts to the local water body, additionally the area disturbed with the proposed project will be significantly less than one acre.
3. WDFW will continue to pursue proper permitting for the Bogachiel Hatchery Improvement Project. WDFW acknowledges Ecology's comments are not meant to represent an exhaustive list of all requirements, but that it is the responsibility of the applicant to obtain all required permits.

Thank-you for Ecology's comments and we will work diligently to secure all necessary permits required prior to any construction.
