The Roza Dam Sediment Removal Project was determined to be a NEPA compliance Categorical Exclusion. The actions of this project do not individually or cumulatively have a significant impact on the environment.

Categorical Exclusions:

516 DM 6 Appendix 9 Bureau of Reclamation 9.4. *Categorical Exclusions*. In addition to the actions listed in the Departmental categorical exclusions outlined in appendix 1 of 515 DM 2, many of which Reclamation also performs, the following Reclamation actions are designated categorical exclusions unless the action qualifies as an exception under 516 DM 2.3A(3):

C.3 - Minor construction activities associated with authorized projects which correct unsatisfactory environmental conditions or which merely augment or supplement or are enclosed within existing facilities.
