Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the determination of nonsignificance for the Roses Lake Access Redevelopment project. We have reviewed the documents and have the following comments.

WATER QUALITY

Erosion control measures must be in place prior to any clearing, grading, or construction. These control measures must be effective to prevent soil from being carried by stormwater runoff into stormwater drains that may discharged directly to surface water. Sand, silt, and soil will damage aquatic habitat and are considered pollutants.
