WDFW has received your SEPA comment concerning the Naselle Hatchery Renovation (DNS-19-009). Changes to the wastewater control facilities at this hatchery will occur in a later phase, which is not yet fully designed. This large project will consist of three or more phases. The pollution abatement ponds are not part of Phase 1. WDFW will submit the requested engineering report and detailed plans to Ecology once this piece of the project is fully designed, when permits are sought for the phase of the project involving new pollution abatement ponds.
