Thank-you for your agency's review of the SEPA DNS for the Weatherly Wildlife Area Forest Thinning Project. Regarding Ecology's comments on road work. WDFW will comply with all Washington State Forest Practice Rules and make sure this project follows the agency Road Maintenance and Abandonment Plan. Thank you for providing contact information for questions. There is at least one existing culvert crossing on a typed stream for this project. This road is being maintained as an open forest road. Water type modifications will be submitted in the spring of 2019. If additional Ns streams are crossed and lack established fords or sufficient rocking, crossings will be identified on the Forest Practices Application and will adhere to the WAC 222-24-040 mentioned in the comment.
